Meeting Jesus: Jesus and the Pharisees Luke 23:32-43 Jeff Heiser, March 8, 2020

Step 1: Reflect on the Text

Read the Scripture printed above. What stands out to you? What do you find interesting and/or important? What is challenging or causes you to have questions?

Step 2: Reflect on the Sermon

INTRODUCTION

- 1. What did Jeff mean when he said that the first thief was stuck in his present reality? What might be a consequence of an earthly or temporal vision of our salvation?
- 2. What was your one, big takeaway from the sermon? How would you summarize the main theme of the sermon in one phrase or sentence?

THE THIEVES (vv. 39-42)

- 1. One thief mocked him, and the other believed in him, but they both died that day. Why is it significant that Jesus doesn't offer *either* thief an end to their crucifixion?
- 2. Share a time that the Lord has used pain or discomfort to draw you or others to himself.

JESUS (v. 43)

- 1. In your own words, explain the Biblical concept of Paradise. In light of this, how does Jesus' offer of salvation differ from the first thief's expectations of salvation?
- 2. Jeff said these words: "The first one home is a thief." What are the implications of this truth? How does it comfort you?

Step 3: Final Reflections

- 1. How has your understanding, appreciation, and love for Jesus and the gospel grown as a result of this study?
- 2. In what areas of faith and practice are you feeling convicted by the Holy Spirit to act as a result of this study?
