

Sermon Discussion Guide 1 John: Searching for Certainty 1 John 3:11-24 Jeff Heiser, October 20, 2019

Step 1: Reflect on the Text

Read the Scripture printed above. What stands out to you? What do you find interesting and/or important? What is challenging or causes you to have questions?

Step 2: Reflect on the Sermon

INTRODUCTION

- 1. How has the use of technology in your family hurt or helped your relationships, both inside the family and without?
- 2. What was your one, big takeaway from the sermon? How would you summarize the main theme of the sermon in one phrase or sentence?

LOVE THE FAMILY (vv. 11-15)

- 1. Discuss how churches have become "lifestyle enclaves." How do you think would John confront some of the tendencies of the modern church?
- 2. Saint Cyprian said, "No one can have God for his Father, who has not the Church for his mother." How could loving the church become a powerful witness to the world?

LOVE LIKE CHRIST (vv. 16-18)

- 1. Discuss how an understanding of love as approval could lead ultimately to loneliness and disconnection from others. How is Christ's love radically different from our culture's definition of love?
- 2. Read v. 18. Share stories of when you have been loved "in deed and in truth."

LOVE WITH CONFIDENCE (vv. 19-24)

- 1. We need a solid foundation of non-anxiety from which to love each other boldly and self-sacrificially. Discuss how God's love allows gives us freedom to love each other well.
- 2. In v. 24, John speaks of the Holy Spirit abiding in us. How is the promise of the Holy Spirit the ultimate proof of our Father's love?

Step 3: Final Reflections

- 1. How has your understanding, appreciation, and love for Jesus and the gospel grown as a result of this study?
- 2. In what areas of faith and practice are you feeling convicted by the Holy Spirit to act as a result of this study?
