Step 1: Reflect on the Text

Read the Scripture printed above. What stands out to you? What do you find interesting and/or important? What is challenging or causes you to have questions?

Step 2: Reflect on the Sermon

INTRODUCTION

- 1. Do you like to pray? Why or why not?
- 2. What was your one, big takeaway from the sermon? How would you summarize the main theme of the sermon in one phrase or sentence?

THE GOD WHO OVERSEES (vv. 23-28)

- 1. How does God oversight—or sovereignty—unsettle you? Does it comfort you in any way?
- 2. Think about your own struggles with prayer. How does God's sovereignty speak into some of your specific struggles?

THE GOD WHO KNOWS OUR NEEDS (vv. 29-31)

- 1. What do you feel like you need to become truly others-centered?
- 2. To what things do you look to meet your felt needs? Does the fact of the crucifixion have anything to say to those things?

Step 3: Final Reflections

- 1. How has your understanding, appreciation, and love for Jesus and the gospel grown as a result of this study?
- 2. In what areas of faith and practice are you feeling convicted by the Holy Spirit to act as a result of this study?
