4. Is it possible to be both healthily self-suspicious and confident? Can you think of stories in Scripture that identify this?

FAITHFULNESS IN THE JOURNEY (vv. 11-34)

5. Can you think of a story from your life that reminds you of God's character? When challenged in your faithfulness along the journey, remember these acts of faithfulness from God in your life.

1. How has your understanding, appreciation, and love for Jesus and the gospel grown as a result of this study?
2. In what areas of faith and practice are you feeling convicted by the Holy Spirit to act as a result of this study?
