INTRODUCTION

1. If you knew that you had one last conversation with a person that you loved, what kinds of things would you want to say? What would you be sure to include? Why?
2. What was your one, big takeaway from the sermon? How would you summarize the main theme of the sermon in one phrase or sentence?

GRACE TO BUILD US UP

3. Ronnie suggests that grace changes our motivations and desires. How were Paul's motivations changed according to vv33-35? Can you relate to the illustration of internal motivations of a husband giving flowers to his wife? How do you see this dynamic in your life?

GRACE FOR AN INHERITANCE

4. Most Christians understand the message of grace exclusively in terms of forgiveness. Paul associates grace with receiving an inheritance (cf. v32). What metaphor did Ronnie use to describe an inheritance? What part did you resonate with?

6. In what areas of faith and practice are you feeling convicted by the Holy Spirit to act as a result of this study?
