- 5) Read Philippians 2:1-10 together.
 - a) How did Jesus move towards us?
 - b) What kinds of examples does Paul give for how we might move towards others?

6) Can you think of a time in your life when God's promises and words to you 'lifted you up' and gave you the ability to persevere?
